- Submission of qualifying certificates shall be done 5 days after the closure of enrollment.



World Environment Day 2021 Celebration on 5th June 2021.




Webinar_Research methodology on 15th January 2022









WEBINAR ON CHANGING ROLE AND STATUS OF WOMEN IN FAMILY



WEBINAR ON WOMEN AND HUMAN RIGHTS








WEBINAR ON TEAM BUILDING











THEME DANCE ON ANTI DOWRY & MANUSCRIPT RELEASE

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
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❖ HARVEST FESTIVAL (01/11/2021)




