

INSTITUTIONAL DISTINCTIVENESS

The college has a long-term planning for the growth and development that is reflected in its Perspective Plan. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the college takes initiatives in the preparation of the perspective plan. The Principal and IQAC coordinator consider the quality indicators of certain criteria determined by NAAC. Also, the framework of plan is inclined towards the development of the college that refers to the quality sustenance and quality enrichment. 1) INFRASTRUCTURE: As part of Infrastructural developments, the institution with the help of its Management, extends its facilities by constructing a new three storeyed building with proper Laboratory facilities and additional classrooms. To Implement Structural Repairs to Building and Electrical Repairs. To Implement the recommendations made by Audit Team which conducted Green Audit & Energy Audit, carried out by the Institution; To make space available for the operation of Canteen for both students & staffs; To create Additional Lecture Rooms by optimally utilizing the existing space; To provide resources required for use of technology to provide online course contents, video lectures, etc. Introducing a greater number of solar panels to effectively reduce the consumption of conventional electricity and to utilise renewable energy resources utmost.
