
VANAMAHOLSAVAM – 07 July 2021

INDEPENDENCE DAY – 15 August 2021






NATIONAL TEACHER'S DAY – 05 August 2021


WORLD OZONE DAY – 16 September 2021


CASHEW TREE PLANTING - 29 October 2021


INTERNATIONAL MOTHER LANGUAGE DAY – 21 February 2022
