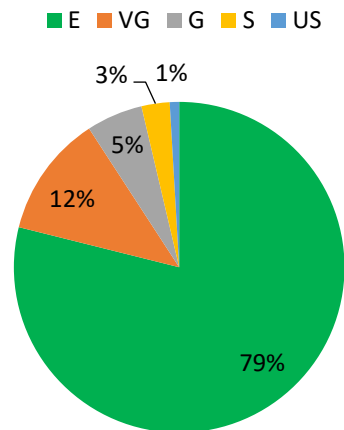

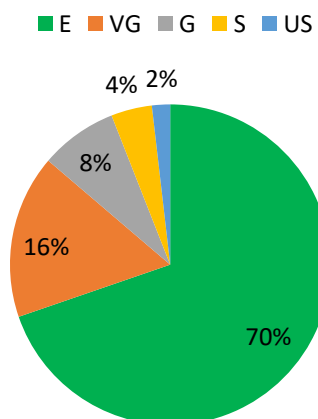

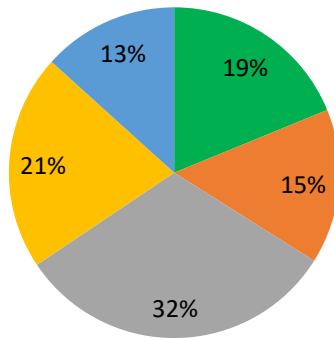

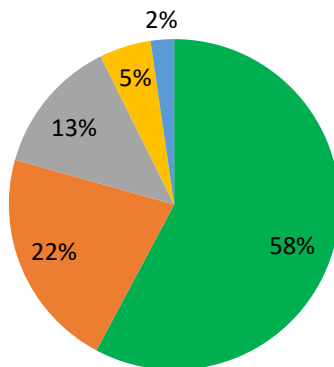

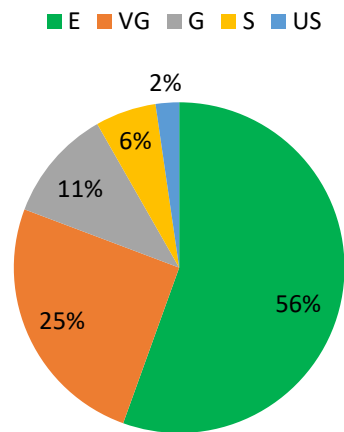


5. Promotion of cocurricular activities

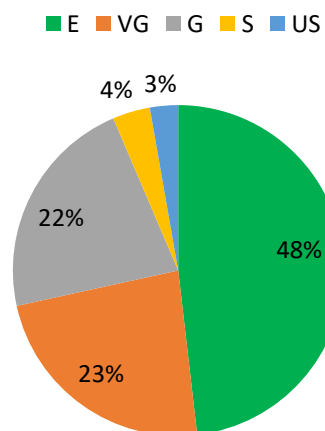


6. Library facility

Library facility

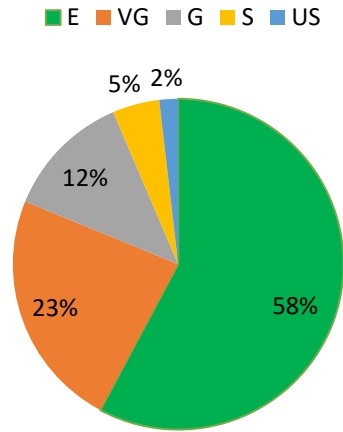


7. Student's grievance redressal mechanism

Students grievance redressal mechanism

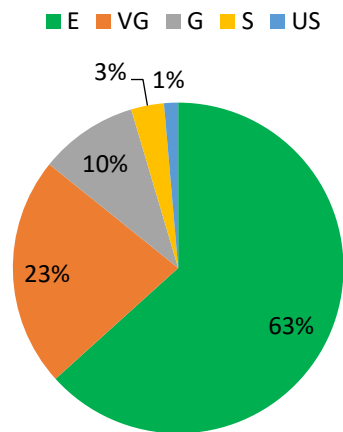


8. Teacher - Student relationship

Teacher student relationship

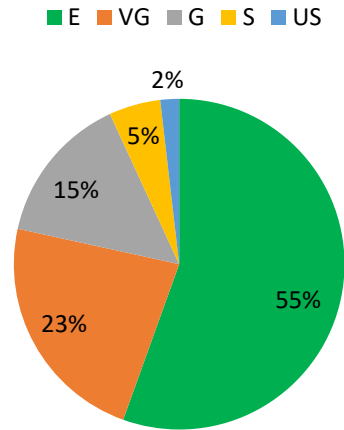

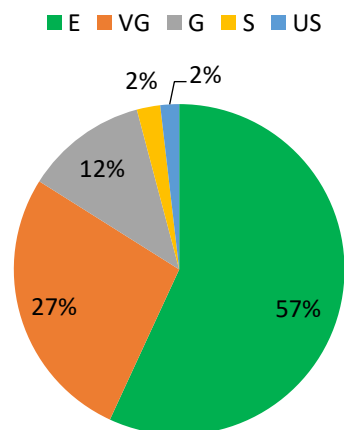


10. Overall campus experience
