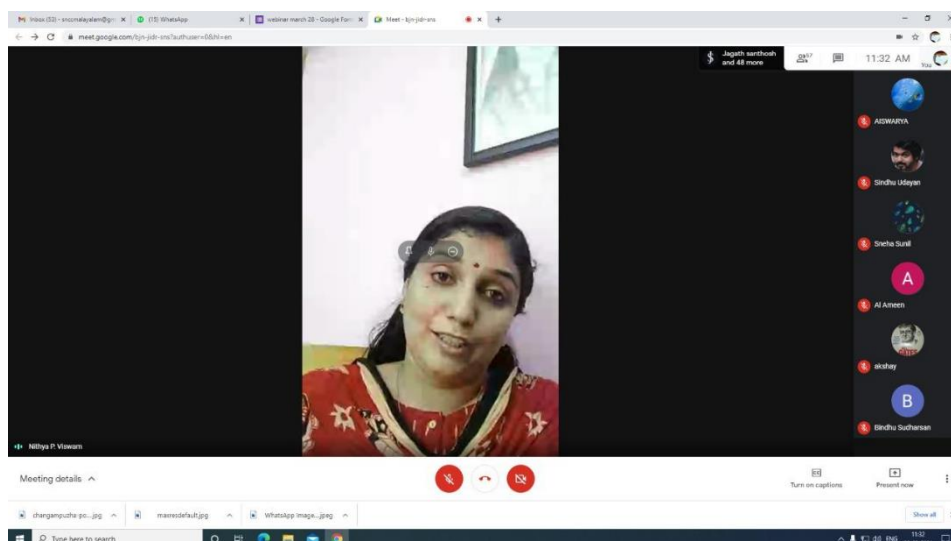

#### **WEBINAR SERIES ‘GENDER EQUALITY-WOMEN LOOKS AHEAD (MARCH 7-24)**

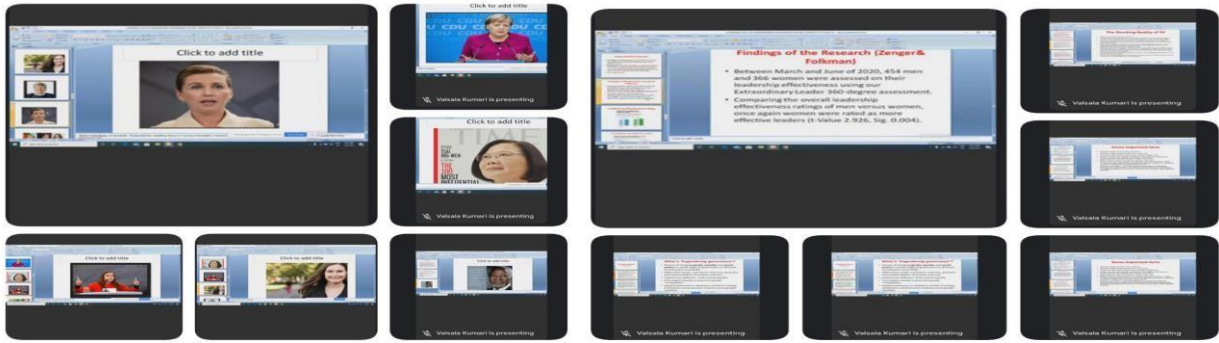

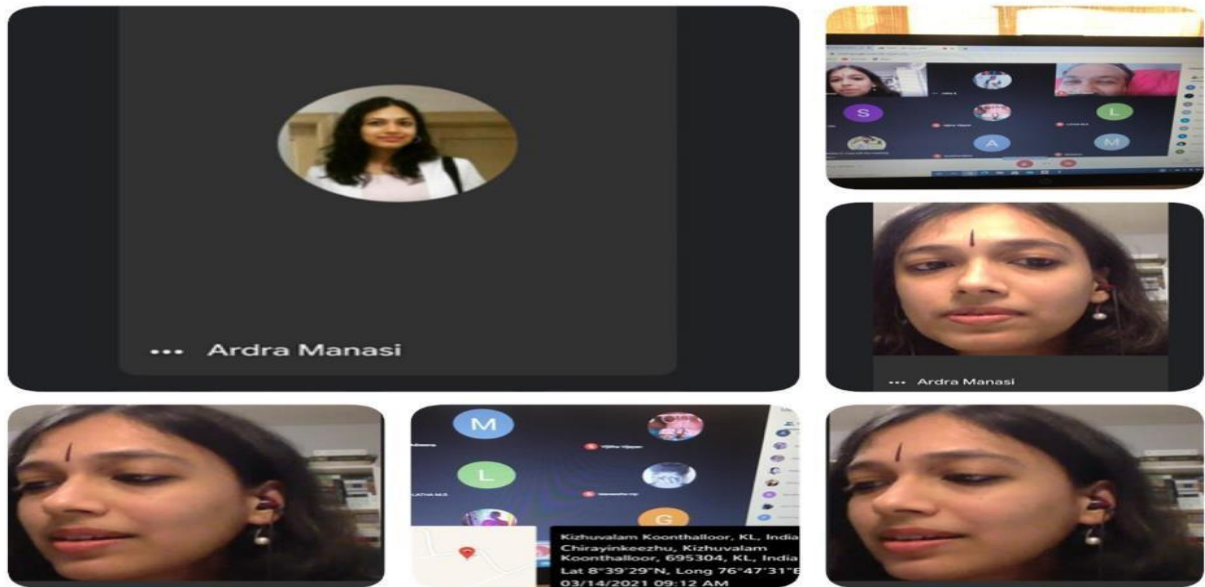

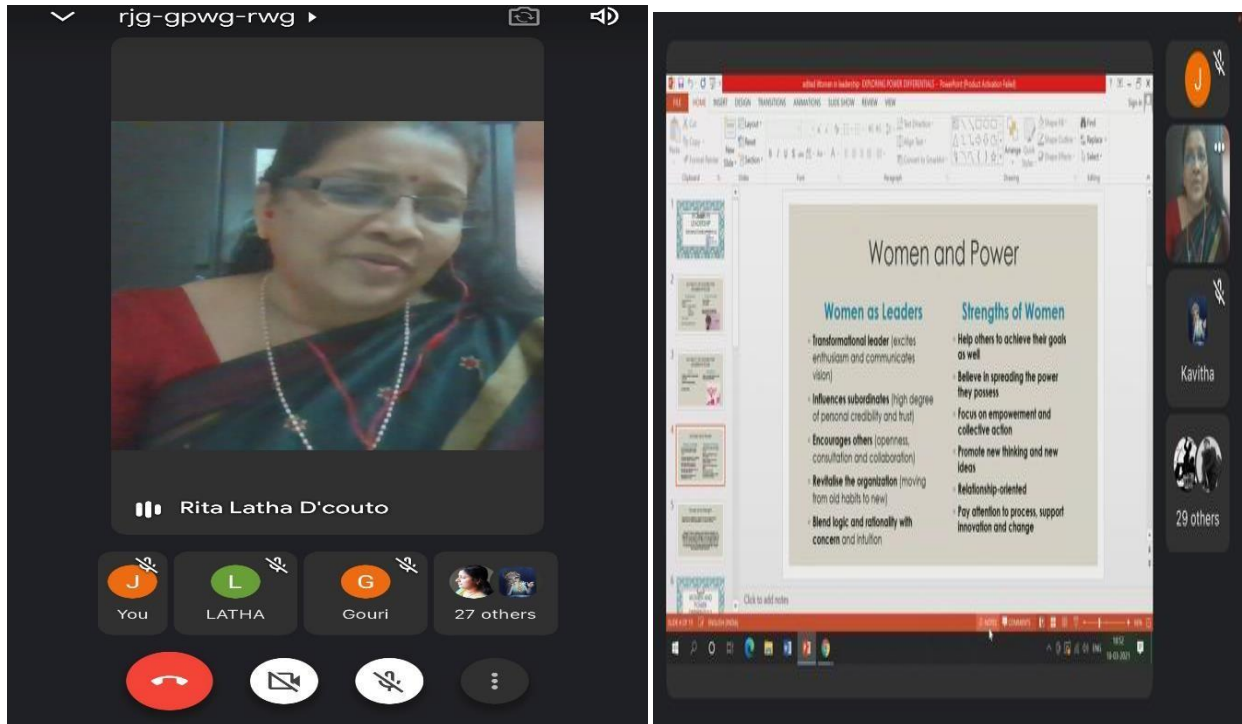
