1. INTRODUCTION

As part of our **extension activities**, we had given previous year solved question papers of SSLC and PLUS -Two Mathematics for students in college ward, those having no additional support for study.










E-Quiz in connection with the National Level


- encourage relaxation and reduce stress. Practicing yoga is said to come with many benefits for both mental and physical health. There is


Entrepreneurship Development Club




to be the equal participants in the country's progress. After the presentations, the resource person responded to all questions from the participants.

 Smt.Meenakshi Vishnu(Aiswarya Velapan) was the resource person who is currently





knowledge of team building and how it helps us in an effective decision making.



National Unity Day




Gurukulam Fest ,Guruvandhanam
