COLLEGE UNION REPORT 2019-2020

The College Union of academic year 2019-20 was formed through the election on 27 September, 2019. A notable programme hosted by the Union is the Clean the Campus Programme during the first week of October. All students with a single mind participated in this effort. The College Union and the Arts Club inauguration was conducted with all pomp and splendour on 3 December,2019. The guest of honour was the notable actor and TV fame Shri. Govind Padmasurya who inaugurated the function. The other dignitaries who marked their presence on the day were Dr. C. S. Subhash Chandran (Principal of the College), Shri. N. On 5 March, 2020 Sports Day was conducted and the Dept. of Mathematics became the champions. Cricket, Volleyball and Football were the major sports held on that day.

DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE

Department of Commerce is the biggest department of this college in terms of student intake and academic achievements. Department runs UG and PG course in Commerce – B. Com and M. Com in finance stream. The department has eight permanent teachers and one part-time law lecturer. The teachers of the department are in charge of various academic and non-academic activities of the college.

The student strength in PG classes is sixteen and the pass percentage is 95%. Janaki M Nair has scored the highest marks for second semester examinations held during the year and she is the University topper for this semester. The students actively participated in various programmes organized by the entrepreneurship development club and ethics committee UG students have also shown keen interest in various academic and non-academic quests.

DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY

SCHOLAR SUPPORT PROGRAMME 2019-2020

Scholar Support Programme in Sree Narayana College, Chathannoor started in academic year 2014-15. SSP aims at extending personalized additional support to students in the subjects of their Weakness included in the curriculum through tutorials study materials, additional lectures, question banks etc. In the previous year the programme was conducted four first year students only. Through SSP student got internal mentoring sessions, external mentoring session for life skill, learning skill and personality development etc.

Around 110 students were expressed their interest in this programme and submitted their profile. Accordingly, 80 students were enrolled for the programme based on their lower marks in the university exam and their plus two examination mark. The selected 80 students were grouped into 8 groups.
