

RED RIBBON ANNUAL REPORT 2022-2023

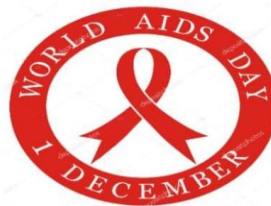
