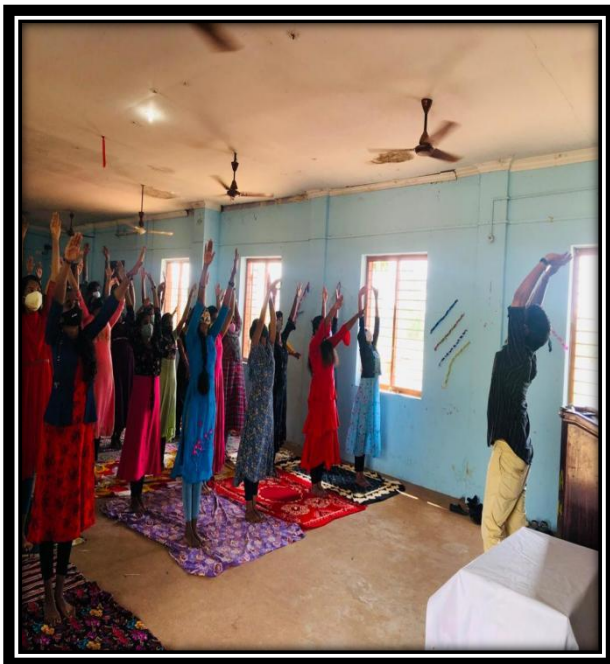

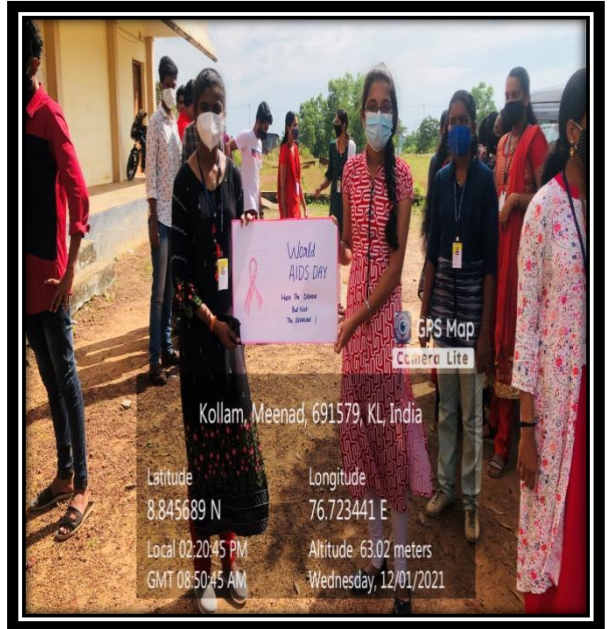

## **HARVEST FESTIVAL ( 01/11/2021)**

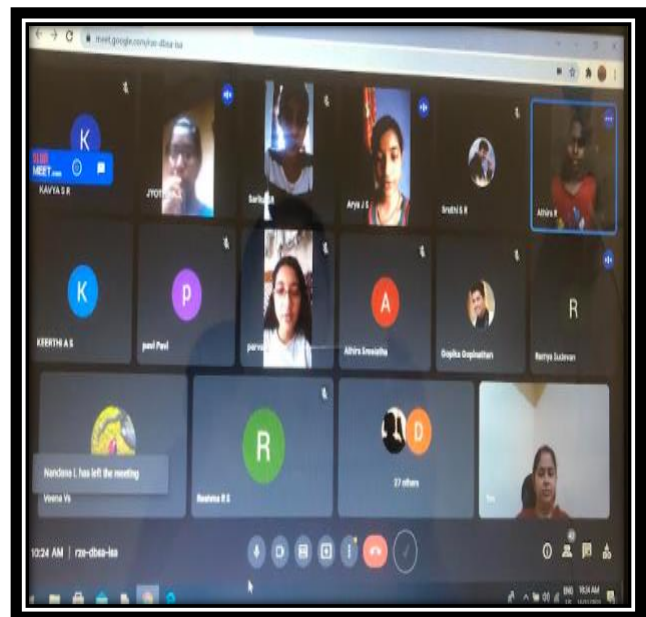

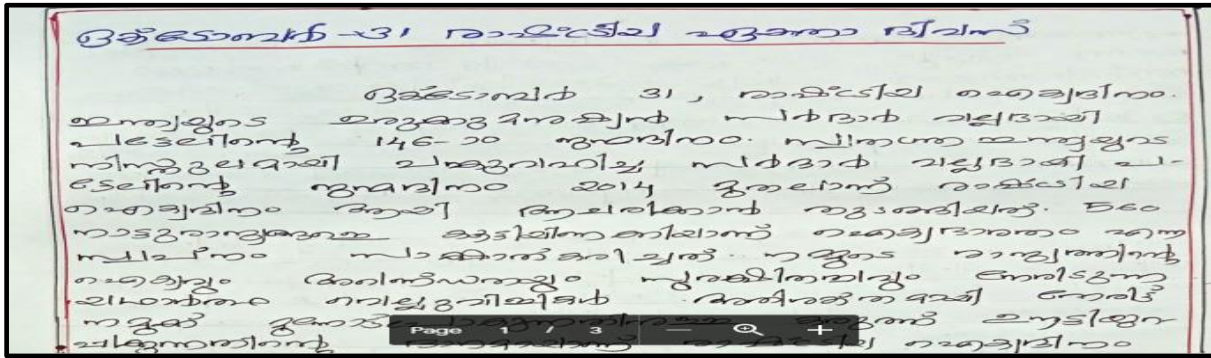
## **NATIONAL UNITY DAY**

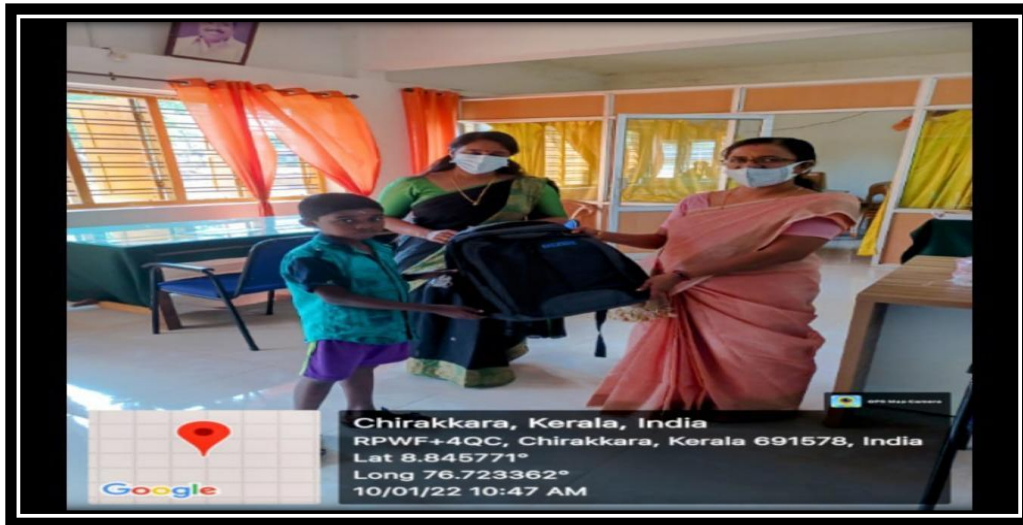

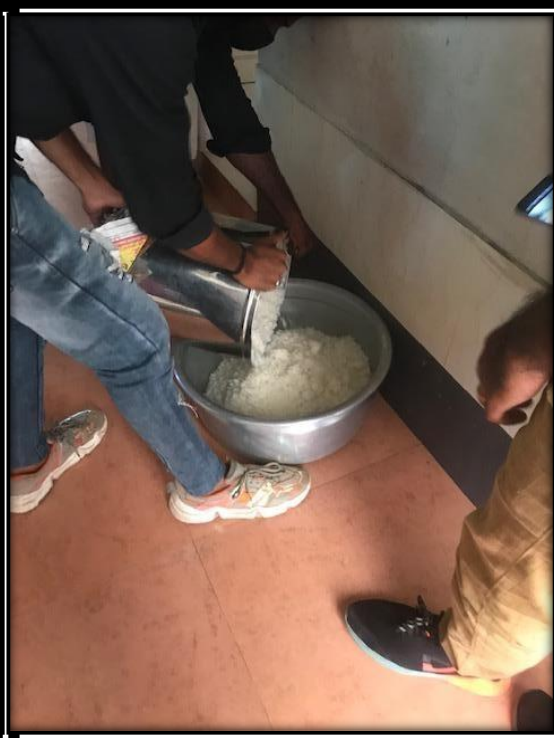
## WEBINAR ON CHANGING ROLE AND STATUS OF WOMEN IN FAMILY
