OLDAGE HOME VISIT (10/03/2022)


10 volunteers from NSS unit of Sree Narayana College Chathanoor visited a Old Age Home on 10th March 2022 and distributed meals to the inmates.


HARVEST FESTIVAL (01/11/2021)

NATIONAL UNITY DAY







THEME DANCE ON ANTI DOWRY & MANUSCRIPT RELEASE






PROGRAMME 2







PROGRAMME 3


WEBINAR ON CHANGING ROLE AND STATUS OF WOMEN IN FAMILY


FIRE AND SAFETY TRAINING

World Environment Day 2021 Celebration on 5th June 2021.




Talk on "Chemistry of Fragrance- Sustainable Utilization of Plant Diversity for Human wellbeing" on 9th March 2022.

The Gandhi Jayanthi Celebrations under the auspicious of the Centre for Gandhian Studies & Department of History,








WEBINAR SERIES 'GENDER EQUALITY-WOMEN LOOKS AHEAD (MARCH 7-24)


Women's Study Unit of Sree Narayana College conducted its second online webinar as part of webinar series in the topic entitled "ENGENDERING GOVERNANCE"






RED RIBBON CLUB ANNUAL REPORT 2020-2021


World Environment Day 2021 Celebration on 5th June 2021.





NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME ANNUAL REPORT 2019-2020

WEBINARS IN COLLABORATION WITH SAKHI: ONE STOP CENTRE ,KOLLAM (MARCH 8-24)





ANNUAL REPORT NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME 2018- 2019

The NSS units of the college carried out several activities both inside and outside the college during the academic year 2018 – 2019. organised many programmes with the co operation of volunteers.

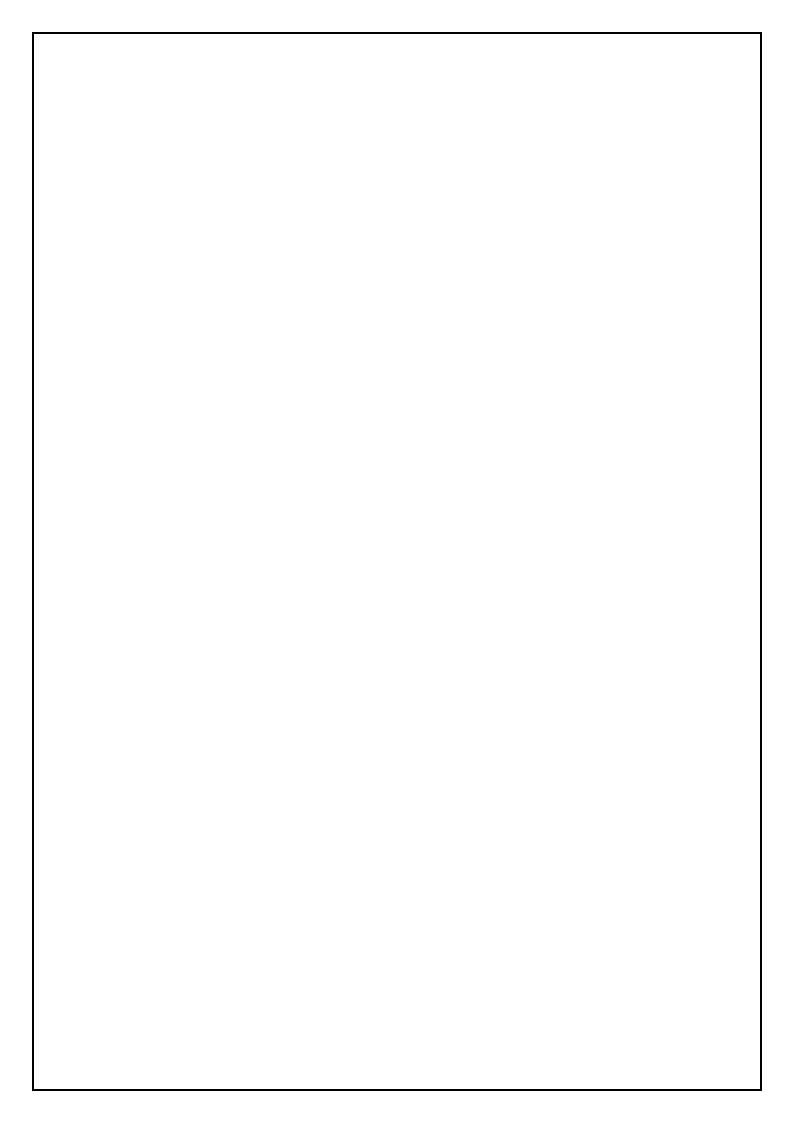
