### **Outcome-Based Education (OBE)**

In alignment with the University's shift to Outcome-Based Education (OBE), the college has undertaken a pedagogical transformation in curriculum delivery. To ensure effective implementation, the IQAC organized two workshops for faculty members. The first workshop focused on the significance of OBE being SMART (Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Relevant, Time-bound) and introduced the revised Bloom's Taxonomy for curriculum and question paper design. The second workshop aimed at revising the Programme Specific Outcomes (PSOs) set by the departments to incorporate the college's vision and mission. It also focused on creating Course Outcomes (COs) for all courses, mapping PSOs and COs both qualitatively and quantitatively, and developing assessment tools based on this mapping.


# OUTCOME BASED EDUCATION SEMINAR ORGANIZED BY IQAC "INTRODUCTION TO OUTCOME-BASED EDUCATION: PRINCIPLES AND PRACTICES" ON 27.10.2023

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Sree Narayana College, Chathannur, organized a seminar on Outcome Based Education titled "Introduction to Outcome-Based Education: Principles and Practices" on October 27, 2023. The seminar aimed to introduce the participants to the principles and practices of Outcome-Based Education (OBE) and its significance in the current educational scenario. The keynote speaker for the seminar was a renowned expert, Dr. Achuthsankar S. Nair, HoD, Department of Computational Biology and Bioinformatics. The event commenced at 10:00 am, beginning with a prayer rendered by our students. Principal Dr. Amjith then delivered the inaugural address and formally launched the seminar, which was further facilitated by a insightful talk from Dr. Sreekala N.B., HoD, Department of Chemistry.

Dr. Achuthsankar S. Nair, an expert in the field of education, began the seminar by explaining the concept of OBE and its importance in ensuring that students achieve specific learning outcomes. He emphasized that OBE is a student-centered approach that focuses on what students can do after completing a program, rather than just what they know. The resource person elaborated on the key principles of OBE, including: Clear and specific learning outcomes, Alignment of curriculum and assessment with learning outcomes, Focus on student-centered

learning and Emphasis on continuous assessment and feedback Dr. Nair also discussed the benefits of OBE, including improved student learning outcomes, enhanced employability, and better accountability. He highlighted the challenges of implementing OBE, including the need for faculty development, curriculum redesign, and assessment reform.

The interactive session encouraged participants to share their thoughts and experiences, fostering a collaborative and insightful discussion. The seminar concluded at 12.30pm, with a vote of thanks by Dr. Parvathy Nand, HoD, PG Dept. of Commerce.


### CO-PO MAPPING WORKSHOP ORGANIZED BY IQAC


### ENTREPRENEURSHIP DEVELOPMENT CLUB 2023-24
